

## SWEATSHIRT & TEE-SHIRT EMBROIDERY Supply List

*Embroidery on these garments is a great project—and will give you great results depending on your design choice, stabilizers and quality of the shirt. In class we will work with provided designs and learn techniques that work best for me. If you have a simple design that you would like to use, please bring that. My “newer” samples are Christmas designs, but anything you choose is fine as long as it is not too stitch intense--machine embroidered applique not appropriate.*

**Bring: Sweatshirt or tee shirt** (adult size) of good quality—all cotton or cotton/poly—pre washing is suggested but not required. The ones usually available at Penney’s, Kohls, Belk or WalMart. are usually good. Try not to get shirts that are really thin or super stretchy like the athletic wear. If you want to use shirts you have on hand for practice that is fine—just be sure they are clean and with plain, usually crew necks instead of “v” neck.

- Embroidery machine with embroidery unit, power cord and embroidery foot
- Hoop—5 X 7” or larger—magnetic hoops are fine also (depends on design)
- USB for design transfer
- Washable or Frixion marker
- Curved Safety Pins and/or paper tape
- Ruler
- Water soluble topping or Sulky Solvy
- Fusible Mesh stabilizer (Power Mesh or No-Show Mesh)
- \*\*\*Tear Away light will be provided at the class
- Bobbin thread bobbin filled
- Embroidery thread assortment
- Embroidery 90/14 needle—new
