

## **BEGINNER SEWING PILLOWCASES**

### **Supply List**

This class is a beginner level sewing project, as you will be making the “Hot Dog Style” full size pillowcases. I hope you will be able to complete two cases, one to keep and one to donate to Cook Children’s Hospital. I will supply the three fabrics for these, but you are welcome to bring your own if you want—amounts are listed below.

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

- Basic sewing presser foot
- Neutral color thread and bobbin (such as tan)
- Scissors and pins or “clips” (called “Wonder Clips”)
- measuring tape

We will be trimming and pressing in the class—irons are provided

If you want to bring your own fabrics: 9” X WOF (width of fabric—selvedge to selvedge is 42-45”)—this is the “cuff”

27” X WOF—for the main section of the pillowcase

3” X WOF

for the “trim” between the cuff and the big part
