SCOUT TEE Supply List

This is a beginner level pattern that includes seams, bias facing, setting sleeves, basic hemming and basic pattern use. Choose a simple cotton fabric, no plaids please. This can be made with knit but not in class. We will be using a serger so if you have one please bring that.

- Scout Tee Pattern (available at RSC)
- Woven fabric for your size (works great with our cotton fabrics) 2 yards usually
- Regular scissors (dressmaker bent handle preferred)
- Straight pins—not tiny!!
- Fabric marker
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control
- Thread and bobbin

Pre-wash your fabric if possible--

Go to page 3 of the pattern to find "Finished Garment Measurements"—use a tape measure and measure your bust. Your finished size should be at least 4" larger than your bust for ease. Example—Your bust measures 36"—That reads a size 8 at the top of the page--—garment measurement is $40\frac{1}{2}$ "so the 8 should be good.

Trace or cut out the pattern pieces in your size—shirt front, shirt back, cap sleeve & binding

Do Not cut out your fabrics until class!!!
