MACHINE APPLIQUE BASICS Supply List

This class will help you along with machine applique projects from "start to finish". You will work with a paper pattern (provided), tracing, fusing, cutting, positioning, stabilizing and stitching. I love to applique, and want to share with you the basics of steps listed above, and then choosing and working with stitch settings and adjustments on your machine.

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control (no embroidery)

- -bobbin with lightweight thread (pre-filled is fine)
- -Several embroidery threads—especially red, white, brown and blue—others will be available in the classroom to borrow
- -New needle: size Topstitch 90, Universal 80/12 or 90/14
- -Open toe foot (if available) or your "F" (Janome), "N" (Brother), "B" (Viking)
- -1/2 yard of Heat 'n Bond Lite or Steam A Seam II (fusible web)
- -1 yard of light tearaway stabilizer—if you don't have this you can purchase a yard of Totally Stable or Heat 'n Sta in the fabric department
- -Fine point Sharpie pen (black)
- -Scissors—smaller size preferred--not curved
- -Applique Press Sheet -optional but very helpful

Fabrics will be provided at the class
