

EMBROIDERED PUMPKIN MATS

Supply List

These mats are so fun and so versatile—you will want to make several! Choose your fabrics and your size and we will get started embroidering! The original download from Janine Babich is for three different sizes— $5 \frac{3}{4} \times 8"$, $7 \times 9 \frac{1}{2}"$ and $7 \frac{3}{4} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}"$ —if you want a different size, your machine or embroidery software will help. I made an assortment of sizes and it worked great.

Bring: Embroidery machine with embroidery foot and power cord

- USB for design transfer if you need help or download

- Embroidery hoop in your size choice— $6" \times 10"$, $8" \times 12"$, $9" \times 14"$
(different machine models offer different sizes)

- Power mesh (no-show) cutaway stabilizer to fit hoops

- Cotton batting—bring Insul-bright if you want protected trivet

- Fabrics— $\frac{1}{4}$ yard will do one pumpkin with a little extra

Pumpkin backs are usually same fabric as fronts

- Threads—Quilting color (crosshatch), stem color, satin detail

I used embroidery threads and embroidery bobbin

If you plan to add words think about that thread color.

- Scissors, point turner

- Basting Spray (KK)

- Paper tape and a few pins

- Steam a Seam 2 tape to close
back fabric
