

# EMBROIDERED QUILTING

## “QUILT WITH EMBROIDERY”

### Supply List

Put your embroidery machine to work to complete your project with quilting. There are many designs available that you can choose from, and some you can design on your own such as using “Design Center” on some Brother machines. In this class we will use pre-digitized designs on “practice” quilt blocks and spaces. The goal is placement and design to give you ideas. I will have samples and designs for you to choose from and look at.

“Edge to Edge” is not included in this class, but is available in another class most quarters at our store.

Bring: Embroidery Machine with Embroidery Unit and Embroidery Foot

- Power Cord

- Hoops—8” minimum if possible, square is handy, magnetic is great

\*\*if you have questions about hoops just ask!!

(I love the 9 and 10” squares—and 8 X 12 rectangles, different brand machines offer different sizes—we won’t use the “giant” hoops in class)

- 1/2 yard of cotton or cotton/poly batting

- 1 yard “tone on tone” or solid cotton fabric, any color for backings

- Fabric marker—Frixion, washable or chalk

- Ruler

- Scissors for trimming threads

- 90/14 embroidery or quilting needle

- Cotton (Aurifil) or Embroidery threads (any colors for top threads)

- Cotton bobbin (not embroidery bobbin as quilting shows on the back)

\*\*Fabric squares for practice stitching will be provided

*You are welcome to bring an unquilted project for us to look at to help you, but we will not stitch on your project in the class. 0*
