

# MACHINE APPLIQUE WITH WOOL

## Supply List

I love to applique—and using wool for this is so creative and fun! I have lots of wool and wool flannel to work with, and a great assortment of threads which I will share in class. I have chosen two patterns that are seasonal and easy—check the photos below. If you have a pattern you would like to use bring it along.

In class we will trace the enlarged pattern pieces onto fusible web, hand cut them, fuse to a flannel background and stitch. We will be doing "practice stitching" before starting on the project. Just call me if you have questions.

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

- Open toe foot \*\*\*important!!
- Topstitch 14 needles
- Fusible web (Heat & Bond light, Transfil etc)  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard
- Fine point sharpie for tracing
- Sharp scissors (Karen Kay Buckley are great)
- Soft Fusible stabilizer such as Power Mesh
- 1/2 yard SF101 or similar fusible interfacing
- 2 spools of Sulky 30# cotton thread (available RSC)—black & brown/tan
- Light box is nice but not required for pattern placement
- Purchased pattern—please choose one or both for copyright\*\*  
but I will have enlarged pattern copies for you
