Supply List

I apologize for the late date of this list and photo, as we had some last minute "family situations" that changed the plans, so I have taken on the project and hope you will enjoy my choice! Please bring a snack to share on class day!!

The project is "Disappearing Four Patch" and it is super easy but also really pretty, and can be done "scrappy" or following a colorway or fabric selection. My sample is red, white and blue to get started on the 2026 celebration—and I love those colors! I used a charm pack from Swirly Girls which we had as a club quilt years ago and this was just waiting for a project. I cut my accent squares (shown in white print) and used the same throughout the project. I only stitched a table top size as I needed to hurry—but I like it!

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

- 1/4" foot or setting
- ruler (12 to 24") and rotary cutter--sharp!
- Neutral thread for piecing with bobbin
- good needle (80/12)
- 9 or 12" square ruler if available
- rotating mat if available—makes cutting so easy!
- pins or clips if desired

Fabrics: Charm pack in your color choice-or 5" squares in your choice

-Accent squares cut to 5" (I used yardage for these)

****I made 9 squares total for a table topper using 18 charm squares and 18 accent squares—you can make this project any size!!**

-Fabric for sashing if desired (I cut 2" strips) and also stitched strips outside on all sides, plus another border cut 3 ½" .

Photo is without quilting on sashings and borders and no binding yet—be kind!!!
