

Mondo Bag or “Midi” Bag

This bag is the perfect bag for the beach, weekend get-a-way, or you can tote a lot of your sewing supplies to classes.

This class consists of 2 meetings:


March 10 (10 to 11:00) – Mandatory Intro Class

The pattern and interfacing will need to be purchased prior to this class.

- ❖ This class will last about an hour. No machine necessary. We will go over the pattern, fabric requirements, and an overview of exactly how the bag goes together.
- ❖ There will be homework to be completed before the next class.

March 13 – Sewing Class (10am – 4pm)

- ❖ We will take your completed panel pieces, along with your lining pieces and complete your bag.



Supplies Needed:

- Sewing Machine, Power Cord, and foot
- Basic Sewing Supplies: (ruler, rotary cutter, point turner, seam ripper, scissors, etc.)
- Mondo Bag Pattern and Interfacing
- Fusible Fleece or Fusible Foam – 1 ¼ yards. If fleece is less than 40”, you will need to be able to cut four pieces, approximately 9” x 40” and two pieces 2 ½” x 26”
- Or
- *Optional*, swivel hook for key ring

Fabric Options: (based on 40” wide usable fabric)

- 14 – 2 ½” x 40” strips of fabric (12 strips will be used for the bag and 2 strips will be used for the handles),
- or
- 48 – 5” squares can be used instead of 2 ½” squares, but you will still need the 2 ½” strips for handles.
- Bag Lining & Handle: 1 ¼ yards

You Need: 192 – 2-1/2” squares
