## “EASTER BUNNY”

### Supply List

This session of Design Center Club will be partly review for some and a new technique for others. I love to “play around” in Design Center so am always looking for more “involved” projects without having them too difficult. It is also sometimes hard for class when we have so many different machine models—mainly Dream, Luminaire, Stellaire and Aveneer, as they all have slightly different features—so please be patient!!

We will use the scanning mats where applicable (Dream, Luminaire and Aveneer) or USB sticks with a jpeg design on them.

Class will involve: scanning or downloading a basic jpeg—center and save

- editing or “correcting” the image-enlarging and drawing
- “erasing” to smooth a line connection
- adding and saving an outlined image
- adding “fills”, colors and stitches to the image
- saving different “parts” for layering
- editing all parts in the “Next” area and saving to Embroidery Edit—using the “link” feature
- Add words if desired
- Preparing towel or fabric for embroidery—hooping & stabilizing
- Centering image and preparing to embroider

Bring: Brother Embroidery machine with Design Center feature

- Embroidery Unit
- Embroidery Foot and Power Cord
- Stylus or Mouse
- Scanning Mat (if available)
- 8 ½” to 10 5/8” hoop (magnetic is fine)
- Tear Away stabilizer—iron on preferred (Heat & Sta)
- Kitchen towel-(not terry cloth) in color that compliments your bunny
- USB for design/image transfer
- Embroidery bobbin
- Scissors
- Threads for stitch out—see sample photo—the “bunny” needs two shades for texture building

\*\*If you don’t want to stitch out the design in class you can bring your USB and do the “work” only.
