

MACHINE EMBROIDERED APPLIQUE

Supply List—March 16 @ 6:00

This class will cover the basics of Machine Embroidered Applique, using simple designs so that you can understand the process. We are not making a “project”, but stitching samples that I will provide the designs for. It’s fun—and you will want to do more!

Bring: Embroidery Machine with Embroidery Unit and Embroidery Foot

- Power cord
- Embroidery Hoop (5 X 7 is great or 4” if that is largest)
- Embroidery bobbin (pre-filled is great)
- Sharp, pointed scissors (curved applique is great)
- Threads—Bring an assortment of embroidery threads
- Good machine needle
- USB stick for design transfer
- Tear Away stabilizer (just bring a roll that will fit your hoop)
- Fabric Scraps—just a few colors—small pieces—and I will have plenty here if you don’t have them!

We will do a unicorn with glitter vinyl, and maybe a mylar design if time allows. Your USB will also have a Sunbonnet Sue design for you to stitch at home, as it takes a while to stitch out—but is so pretty!



I will provide Fusible Web for you at class and a napkin for you to stitch a design onto
