

CHARMING STARS TABLE RUNNER

Supply List

This is an easy quilting project using basic sewing and piecing techniques and taking a look at the quilting process. You will work with easy cuts of fabric, cut and piece and form your table runner—it's fun!

Bring: 26 5" cotton fabric squares—or—1 "Charm Pack"—available at Richland Sewing Center in a variety

of colors and prints, in the "Pre-Cuts" section

5/8 yard of cotton solid or "tone on tone" for the blocks, sashing and inner border

4 5" squares for small blocks (also from Charm Pack) or cut your own

½ yard Cotton print for outer border

3/8 yard print or solid for binding (outer edge) (you can choose your border and binding later)

2 yards X 45" for backing

batting for quilting layer (available at RSC)

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control
- 1/4" foot or setting (if not available I can set your needle position)
- Rotary Cutter
- 24" Quilt Ruler (6 or 6 ½" wide)
- Fabric Marker—Frixion, chalk or water soluble
- Small ruler for marking lines
- Straight pins
- Neutral cotton thread and bobbin (usually tan or gray)
