

RUFFLER PLACEMAT

Supply List

This project is fun and unique, and teaches you how to do several techniques that you may not be comfortable with including cutting bias, binding curves, working with foam and using the ruffler attachment.

Bring: Fabric “fussy cut” for mat center--**if you want to quilt this you can bring your embroidery machine, or do some simple quilting with your walking foot—sample shown was quilted in embroidery.

The center fabric will be trimmed to 7 or 8 inches, so have a piece at least 9” square to prepare your center circle

--2 3 ½” strips WOF for ruffle

--30” of 1 ¼” bias for flange—I will help you cut this at class

--60” of 2 ½-2 5/8” strips cut on the bias for binding

--15-16” square of Bosal or Flex Foam fusible on one side

--15” square of lightweight batting

--15-18” square of fabric for placemat back

**I will provide fusible fleece and SF101 to back your circle

-Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

**embroidery unit, foot and hoop if you plan to embroider center

-1/4” foot or setting

-Walking foot if available

-Ruffler attachment

-Scissors, rotary cutter and basic sewing supplies

-Curved safety pins—just a few

-Pencil and Washable/iron off marker

-Thread and bobbin to match ruffle fabric

***If you have a small iron and mat that would be helpful*
