

TEE SHIRT QUILT

Supply List

- Bring:** Tee shirts that have been washed and pressed
DO NOT cut before class!!
- Interfacing for backing—Pellon 906F (available by the yard at Richland) lightweight is best
 - Rotary Cutter and rulers 12 ½” square or 15” square or size large enough for shirt “design” on front
 - Iron—classroom irons are available and we will also use the “press” and hand press for good fusing
 - If you only have a small number of tee shirts you might want to use a background fabric to “float” the shirts. Consider fabric for borders as well
 - Scissors, pins
 - Sewing machine with accessories

This session is mostly prep and planning for your quilt, so that you will be prepared to stitch your top together!
