

Fall Cutwork Class

May 8, 2026

Supplies and Materials:

Embroidery Machine and Power Cord Embroidery Unit, Embroidery foot, and 5" x 7" embroidery hoop

Embroidery Needles, 75/11 USB stick with designs loaded in your machine's format

Napkin or woven fabric for the embroidery (I will have a napkin for you at class)

Embroidery Thread: Burnt orange; dark green; golden yellow; rust

Embroidery Bobbins wound. Both sides of the design will show, so the bobbin needs to be the same color as the top thread.

Wash-A-Way Stabilizer (I used sticky wash-a-way, which works best on this project. It is expensive. The alternative is plain wash-a-way & adhesive spray)

Spray adhesive

Exacto (new blade) knife and small cutting mat.

Sewing Notions: small scissors, seam ripper, fabric marker, etc.
