

# HAPPY VILLAGES LANDSCAPE

## Supply List—June 12, 2026 @ 10:00

This class will be an adventure in creativity and fun—and if you don't feel creative—we will guide you—it's fun! You will start with a blank "canvas" (actually a piece of cotton over batting), build a "background" of water, hills and sky, and then build your village. We will provide basic pattern shapes and the "how to" steps.

Sewing will be done at home—and the neatest feature is covering the entire creation with tulle and stitching through that—just mostly straight stitches around your shapes and then adding a little "texture".

Before class—think about your "picture" and find some fabrics that will look good—and back those with fusible web—but not the "background" fabrics that will be your blank "scene". You have a page of shapes that will help you with buildings that you should cut out the paper before class, and in class you will cut the backed fabrics to place in your background.

**Bring:** Back all of these with fusible web before class!!

Background—Sky—5" X 11"

Water—10 X 11"

Land—3" X 9"

Roof tops—6" squares of 2 or 3 prints (that might look like roofs)

Doors and Windows—any size darks-black, dk gray, brown

Buildings—6" squares of 5 colors

Scraps—flowers, bushes, trees

To "build" on—foam core board 12" X 14" minimum—Heat & Press  
firm cardboard **Batting**—14" X 11" Backing added later

-Scissors—Karen Kay Buckley work great-or other small sharp ones

-Straight pins—for holding pieces in place
