

# Rag Quilt Class

## Supply List

### Fabric Requirements:

1/2 yard each of 7 different coordinating fabric for the top  
3 1/4 yards white flannel for the middle layer  
3 1/4 yards backing fabric (I use all one fabric)

This will make a quilt finishing about 49" x 70"

\* You could do this with 10" layer cakes. Squares will finish at 9".  
Using 54 squares, this quilt would finish around 54" x 81".  
In addition, you'll need 4 yards white flannel and 4 yards backing fabric.

### Other Supplies:

Fabric snips for rag quilts (I'll bring several variations if you'd like to try before you invest in a good pair)  
Neutral or coordinating color thread & matching bobbin  
( \* I've always used white thread for the "X" in the squares, no matter what the fabric is.)  
Rotary cutter (with a sharp blade!)  
Ruler for cutting 8" squares (or 10" if using a layer cake)  
Sewing machine with power cord and foot control  
All-purpose/standard presser foot  
Fabric clips and/or pins OPTIONAL
