

ONE BLOCK WONDER

Supply List

This project is SEW fun!! Pick a panel or fabric and prepare to be amazed--we have two days to get you a good start and have fun! Class times are July 11 @ 12:00 and July 18 @ 10:00 (all day)

Bring: Book "One Block Wonder"--*this is helpful but not required.*

There are actually three titles available here. There are photos and basic instructions in each book.

If you can pull up the "One Block Wonder Design Helper" on your phone, it will give you an idea of what your fabric choice would look like after cutting and stitching the hexagons.

-Fabric--7 panels if using panels OR 4 ½ yards of a special fabric that we will cut into "repeats". *We do split the yardage down the middle (don't tear) so that each "strip" cut is only 22-24" . The other half can be used for borders or stitched for backing.* **NOTE: If you are using a panel for the project, we will NOT cut down the middle, either a 24" or 1 yard panel.**

-60 degree triangle ruler (either size)

-Rotary cutter (60mm preferred) with sharp blade

-24" ruler for cutting across fabrics

-Flat Head Pins

-Sewing machine in good working order--foot control & cord

-1/4" foot or setting

-Sewing thread (Aurifil suggested) and bobbin

If you have questions just ask --it really is a fun project!
