

LEARN TO SEW (Beginner Sewing)

Supply List

This class will get you off to a great start using a pattern, learning more about your machine, basic fitting and sewing skills and having fun! Please take a look at the photo here and think about your design choice—there is a sample of the pants in our classroom if you want to see the “real thing”. ***Your pattern will be provided at the class at no extra charge.*** Most of your supplies are available at RSC (Richland Sewing Center) and you will get a 10% discount

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

RECOMMENDED—If you do not know much about your machine and have not used it much (or not at all) I suggest you take the “Machine Basics” class on July 9th at 6:00. You will learn about the bobbin, threading and making stitch adjustments on your machine

- Standard sewing foot for your machine
- Thread and bobbin in coordinating color (Cotton or Polyester—not embroidery thread **available at RSC
- Fabric for your project—Suggested—cottons, lightweight denim linen or a blend—no knits or plaid fabrics please

Most sizes need **2 ½ yards of 45” wide fabric**—pre-washing is recommended due to shrinkage. We have a great selection here at RSC for you to choose from, otherwise Hobby Lobby or Walmart have fabrics.

- Shears (bent handle recommended) for cutting out your fabrics
- Straight pins—“yellow head” are great—don’t get tiny ones
- Marker—Washable or iron-away (Frixion)
- Tape measure
- Seam gauge (small ruler)
