Disappearing Pinwheel Illusion Quilt Class Supply List



Join us for a super fun project making a disappearing pinwheel illusion quilt using pre-cuts!

You'll be amazed how easy this is! Please don't be intimidated by how complex this design looks.

This class will teach you how to make one block and how to arrange the blocks for the final quilt design.

You can stay and make as many blocks as you wish in the time allotted for the class, but you will not have time during class to make all the blocks necessary to complete the quilt.

Fabric Requirements:

To get 36 finished blocks resulting in a quilt top of 63" x 63" WITHOUT borders:

1 package of 10" squares as the print fabric

1 package of 10" squares as the lighter background fabric.

To get 64 finished blocks resulting in a quilt top of 84" x 84" WITHOUT borders:

Requires an additional 22 10" squares of print fabric and 22 10" squares of lighter background fabric.

You can also choose to cut your own 10" squares. You will need 36 10" squares of print fabric and 36 10" squares of lighter background fabric. You will need 64 10" squares of each (print and background) if making the larger size.

Other Supplies:

Rotary cutter (with a sharp blade!)

24" ruler (or ruler that's at least 12")

Squaring tool (will need to square half-square-triangles to 6 1/4")

You can also use an 8 1/2" or 12 1/2" square for this

Basic sewing supplies: scissors, ripper, good needle etc

Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

All-purpose/standard presser foot

1/4" foot or setting

Neutral or coordinating color thread & matching bobbin

Fabric clips and/or pins OPTIONAL

Rotating cutting mat OPTIONAL (big enough for an 11" square)
