

BLANKET STITCH APPLIQUE PROJECT

SUPPLY LIST

This project will finish as a "mug mat", potholder or just a cute finished block! The design will quilt your background then go into the machine embroidered applique. I have chosen the most simple design to allow for "finishing", but if we don't finish it all in class you will know how to complete it at home!!

Fabrics & batting will be in a "kit" (red apple fabrics and leaf)

Bring: Embroidery machine with embroidery unit, power cord and embroidery foot

Hoop: 10" square, 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square - 6 "x 10" There are several design sizes which will determine which hoop you will need. To be "safe"—bring a couple of your hoops—not super large or super small. Magnetic hoops not suggested for this.

- Mesh Cutaway stabilizer to fit hoop (No Show, Power mesh)
- Background Fabric—Light color cotton with SF101 pressed behind
- Border fabrics—fat quarter of two fabrics that look nice with your chosen background-(these form a "frame")
- 1/4 yard of "backing" fabric to make envelope back closure
- Threads: neutral cotton or poly for layering and stipple stitch (tan)
 - 2 shades of red
 - 2 shades of green
 - dk brown for stem
- Poly or cotton 40#**
- Embroidery bobbin (pre-filled is fine) light color
- Embroidery needle (75/11 or 90/14)
- Scissors for trimming—curved or duckbill
- Rotary cutter and ruler

This is a good "machine embroidered applique" design to get you started-there are other designs similar to this available that have more "pieces" in an Anita Goodesign collection.
