

EMBROIDERED HOLIDAY QUILT SUPPLY LIST

I am sew excited about this project and hope you will be too. It is scheduled for three classes, August 15 @ 1:30, August 22 @ 1:00 and Sept 19 @ 10:00. The embroidered blocks are digitized for 7" to 10" squares and each block can take almost an hour to stitch, so that is the reason for the three sessions. You can choose to do a table runner with 5 blocks or a wall hanging with 3 blocks, plus embroidered borders for both. The blocks are beautiful and you will have a choice of designs—the main theme is "Sing Along" holiday.

The Design will be available at RSC for discounted price of \$35—shown on next page.

For the runner: Fabrics—Background -1 yard solid or tone on tone-(not too busy)
(shown in white, ecru or black)

Borders -1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards non directional holiday print

Backing 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Binding $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Batting $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard cotton (Simply Cotton or Soft & elegant)

Cut 5 squares-10" (1 per hooping for blocks)

Optional flange-1/4 yard solid or tone contrast

****If you can cut your background into squares and back with SF101 before class you will be "ready": Cut 5: 12" 11" 10" or 9" (EMBROIDERY SIZE)**

BORDER, FLANGE AND MORE BATTING WILL BE CUT AT CLASS 2

For the Wall Hanging: 1/3 yard Background -cut into 9" to 12" squares (total 3) backed with SF101 (sized for your choice embroidery size)

-1/2 yard for borders-non-directional holiday print

-1/2 yard for binding, sashing and optional flange

-1/2 yard backing

-batting $\frac{1}{2}$ yard as listed above

Basics: Embroidery Machine with embroidery unit and power cord and embroidery foot

-Hoop for your chosen design size -magnetic is OK

-Power mesh cutaway stabilizer—roll wide enough for your hoop

-Fabrics as listed above (background most important & backed for class #1)

-Scissors for trimming and squaring

-Embroidery threads in colors shown or your choice—Christmas and background colors

-Several embroidery bobbins-pre-filled is fine

-Several embroidery needles (I like 90/14, also nice to have a pack of "purple" needles)

-USB for design transfer
