WESTALEE BASICS FOR QUILTING

Supply List

This class is to help you get started--or keep practicing--using the tools and accessories from the Westalee “Sew Steady” Program.

Bring: Sewing Machine with power cord and foot control

- Extend Table (at least 18” X 24”)**

- Free Motion Glider Sheet**

- Starter Kit with ruler foot, gripper tape and 12” Arc ruler

Some starter kits do not have the ruler included, but you will need that—we will stock them separately

- Sampler Set 1—check for High Shank or Low Shank

- Spacing gauge

**if possible!

Several quilt “sandwiches” with two layers of muslin or tone on tone fabric and cotton batting--15”to 18” squares

- Cotton Quilting thread and bobbin (slightly contrasting to fabric)

- Scissors, marker, ripper and general sewing supplies

**optional but suggested--Crosshair Grid with a marker (Westalee)

I know that some of you have lots of other rulers, but for this class we will stay mainly with the basics. Please be familiar with how to adjust your machine for free motion quilting, and maybe practice a bit with your stitching. Don't worry if you are a “raw” beginner!! This is fun!!!

Westalee has introduced a full line of embroidery designs, some to work with the rulers, that I will show.
