

CHENILLE PLACEMAT

Supply List

Learn the technique to do chenille on your sewing machine—then in class construct a placemat and see samples of what you can do with panels or larger fabrics! Jane will teach this class and share the fun!

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

- Walking foot if possible (or built in feed drive)
- Ruler—24 X 6"
- Fabric marking pen—iron off or washable
- Rotary Cutter
- Chenille Cutter—these are really helpful and fun to use
- Small sharp scissors
- Quilting safety pins
- Cotton thread and bobbin (to match back)
- Binding can be added after trimming-not done in class

Fabrics: 5 fat quarters—one should be a "busy" fabric for the back, one will be the bottom (not cut) layer—bold color—the top three will make the wavy chenille

-18" X 22" batting piece
