

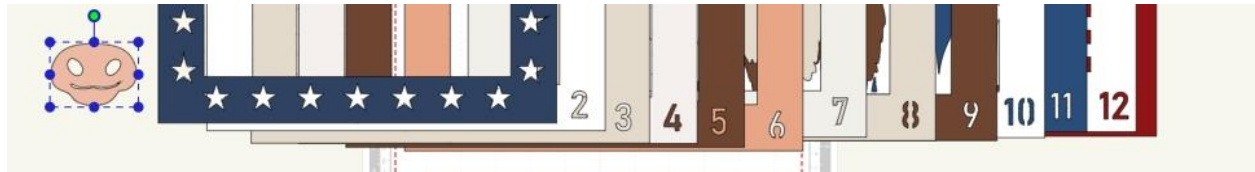
Layered Highland Cow Shadow Box

14 layers - Scan and Cut Project Supply List

This project uses 14 layers of 12"x12" cardstock to create. It's so fun to see them come to life!



Here are the colors I used for each of the layers. You can select your own color as well, as you can tell many of the colors repeat at least twice. This is what helps create the different dimensions.

Supplies needed

Scan N Cut machine with power supply and OLD mat (little or no sticky left on it) This is very important as sticky mats will shred the paper when removing it. I have several old mats I will bring some to share.

Variety of 12" x 12" Cardstock at least 65lb weight - you will need to bring extra as sometimes you might need to cut it more than once.

USB stick so I can copy the design for you

Weeding tool

Scissors

Blue painter's tape
